Brother George Washington

George Washington's journey as a Freemason began in 1752 when he joined the Fredericksburg Lodge in Virginia. His deep commitment to the Masonic values of brotherhood, relief, and truth significantly influenced his leadership and vision for the United States.

Washington's Masonic beliefs shaped his approach to unity, equality, and justice—core principles that guided him during the American Revolution and the drafting of the Constitution. His dedication to integrity and moral character, hallmarks of Freemasonry, earned him widespread respect.

In a symbolic Masonic ceremony in 1793, Washington laid the cornerstone of the United States Capitol building. This event underscored the connection between Freemasonry and the nation's founding, highlighting the impact of Masonic values on American democracy.

His life and work continue to inspire Freemasons and non -Masons alike, emphasizing the importance of the values he upheld.
